- College Student is 19-23 yrs old with a valid college ID
- Ages 11-15 and parent/guardian MUST be a Season Pass holder
- Residence is outside of Washakie County
- Annual Season Pass is extended only to those individual(s) listed on the Season Pass Agreement.
- Season Pass players must follow the Green Hills tee time reservation policy.
- ALL Season Pass players are required to check-in at the golf shop PRIOR to beginning play.
- ALL Season Pass players renting a golf car are required to sign and abide by the Golf Car Rental Agreement.
- Green Hills golf cars are limited to two (2) individuals.
- Fivesomes are only allowed with the approval of the golf shop staff.
- All players must start on Hole #1 unless prior approval from the golf shop staff.
- During inclement weather, it may be necessary to close the facility, this may include the golf course, practice greens, driving range, and the clubhouse.
- ALL Season Pass players are required to adhere to all Green Hills Golf Club policies and procedures.
- Person listed as the primary Season Pass holder IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF ALL PERSONS LISTED ON THEIR SEASON PASS AGREEMENT.
- No Equity or Club Ownership Interest. Your involvement in the club is not an investment in the Clubnor does it provide an equity or ownership interest in the Club or any of the club's facilities. The Club's management has the right to restrict or reserve the Club for maintenance, tournament play, or other special events. Involvement as a pass holder at the Club is a revocable license only and is subject to suspension and revocation for failure to abide by the Club's rules and regulations as now in effect or as amended.

## **DRESS CODE**

No tank tops or cut-off shirts.

Soft spiked golf shoes or spikeless golf shoes are allowed on the course. No metal spikes or cowboy boots are allowed.
